Other Materials Recycled Content Overview:

Packaging has large amounts of recycled content – average corrugated material, where corrugate is used. Packaging materials, plastic banding and skids can be recycled at the jobsite if requested.

Wherever possible, blanket wrap is used thereby eliminating the packaging waste. These packaging options help to support LEED NC & CI – MR 2.1 and MR 2.2 *Construction Waste Management* or LEED EB - MR Prerequisite 1.1 *Source Reduction and Waste Management*.

Other Attributes:

End-of-Life Recycling & Reuse: KI selects materials that can be recycled at the end of a product's use and designs its products so that it can be easily disassembled and separated for local recycling facilities.

Maintenance:

Fabric – Wisk or vacuum regularly. For unusual stains, use a commercial cleaner following manufacturer's instructions.

Vinyl/Polyurethane – Wipe with damp cloth, moistened with a mild detergent solution. For unusual stains, use a commercial nylon cleaner, following manufacturer's instructions.

Other Surfaces – Wipe with soft cloth, moistened in a mild solution. Dry and buff lightly with a dry cloth.

Fabrics: Fabric option is available with this product. Fabrics selections may contain between 0%-100% recycled content. Renewable materials in textiles are also available.
